

## Reading the weather

Numbers below 0°C are called **negative numbers**.

The 'larger' the negative number gets, the colder the weather becomes.

- 2. Which city has the warmest temperature?
- 3. How many degrees below freezing is Glasgow?
- 4. How many degrees above freezing is Swansea?
- 5. Is Aberdeen colder than Glasgow?
- 6. What is the temperature at which water freezes?
- 7. Which city is at the temperature that water freezes?
